Who is the card for?	Formal work placements such as T Levels or degree sandwich courses	For trial periods before starting a formal apprenticeship	For those on a registered apprenticeship	For those on formal qualification to a full Gold card (self-funded/ apprenticeship or other)	For those eligible or undertaking the Experienced Worker Assessment route to Gold card
What is required for the card?	Evidence of enrolment on relevant programme	Employer confirmation plus ECS HSE assessment	Evidence of apprenticeship registration	Evidence of enrolment on recognised qualification route (may include apprenticeship)	Enrolment onto Experienced Worker Assessment or eligibility for enrolment

Note: All ECS cards require a valid ECS Health, Safety and Environmental Awareness assessment to have been completed or a valid exemption held. For some cards, there are no exemptions so please check the card type relevant before making an application.
